

Miss Crazy Handmade

Thin Blue Line Flag Blanket



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Materials/Supplies

- 10.0mm or N sized hook
- Worsted weight yarn
- Scissors
- Tapestry or yarn needle

Difficulty level: Easy

Abbreviations

- Ch- chain
- Sc- single crochet
- St- stitch
- Sl st- slip stitch
- Dc- double crochet
- MR- Magic Ring

Finished Dimensions:

- Baby: 25" x 45"
- Crib: 40" x 60"
- Throw: 52" x 60"
- Twin: 65" x 90"
- Queen: 80" x 90"
- King: 90" x 108"

Pattern Notes: You will be using 2 strands of yarn at a time. Stars are sewn on so leave a tail on each! Pattern is worked in rows. Pattern is for blue line, but feel free to do a traditional flag or change the blue to another color to support firefighters, ems, etc.

Baby Size

(starting with black)

CH84

Row 1: dc in 2nd ch from the hook and across ch2 turn (sts)

Row 2: dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 3-4: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 5-6: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 7-8: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 9-10: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to blue

Row 11-12: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 13-14: ch2, dc in each st across (these two will be all black, after this we will only be changing colors about halfway down the row)

Row 15: ch2, continuing with black dc in the next 37 sts, change to white and continue to end of row

Rows 16: ch2, still using white dc in the next 47 sts, pick up black where you left it and dc to the end of the row

Row 17-18: ch2, still using black, dc in each st across

Row 19-24: repeat rows 15 to 18

Row 25-26: repeat rows 13-14

DO NOT FASTEN OFF, you will now be working on the border, ch 1 and single crochet around the entire blanket, fasten off and weave in ends

Stars

You will be making 50!

Using a 2.75 mm or C hook

Sc 10 into a MR, sl st to first sc

Ch 3, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next, skip one st in beginning round 1 (repeat for 5 points)

Crib

(starting with black)

CH112

Row 1: dc in 2nd ch from the hook and across ch2 turn (sts)

Row 2-3: dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 4-6: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 7-9: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 10-12: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 13-15: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to blue

Row 16-18: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 19-21: ch2, dc in each st across (these three will be all black, after this we will only be changing colors about halfway down the row)

Row 22: ch2, continuing with black dc in the next 50 sts, change to white and continue to end of row

Rows 23: ch2, still using white dc in the next 60 sts, pick up black where you left it and dc to the end of the row

Row 24: repeat row 22

Row 25-36: repeat rows 19 to 24

Row 37-39: repeat rows 19-21

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Stars

You will be making 50!

Using a 3.25 mm or D hook

HDC 10 into a MR, sl st to first hdc

Ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next, hdc in 3rd ch, skip one st in beginning round 1, sl st to next (repeat for 5 points)

Throw

(starting with black)

CH112

Row 1: dc in 2nd ch from the hook and across ch2 turn (sts)

Row 2-4: dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 5-8: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 9-12: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 13-16: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 17-20: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to blue

Row 21-24: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 25-28: ch2, dc in each st across (these four will be all black, after this we will only be changing colors about halfway down the row)

Row 29: ch2, continuing with black dc in the next 50 sts, change to white and continue to end of row

Rows 30: ch2, still using white dc in the next 60 sts, pick up black where you left it and dc to the end of the row

Row 31-32: repeat rows 29-30

Row 33-47: repeat rows 25 to 32

Row 48-52: repeat row 25-28

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Stars

You will be making 50!

Using a 3.25 mm or D hook

HDC 10 into a MR, sl st to first hdc

Ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next, hdc in 3rd ch, skip one st in beginning round 1, sl st to next (repeat for 5 points)

Twin

(starting with black)

CH150

Row 1: dc in 2nd ch from the hook and across ch2 turn (sts)

Row 2-5: dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 6-10: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 11-15: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 16-20: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 21-25: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to blue

Row 26-30: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 31-35: ch2, dc in each st across (these five will be all black, after this we will only be changing colors about halfway down the row)

Row 36: ch2, continuing with black dc in the next 69 sts, change to white and continue to end of row

Rows 37: ch2, still using white dc in the next 79 sts, pick up black where you left it and dc to the end of the row, ch 2

Row 38-40: repeat rows 36-37

Row 41-59: repeat rows 31 to 40

Row 60-65- repeat rows 31-35

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Stars

You will be making 50!

Using a 3.25 mm or D hook

HDC 10 into a MR, sl st to first hdc

Ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next, hdc in 3rd ch, skip one st in beginning round 1, sl st to next (repeat for 5 points)

Queen

(starting with black)

CH150

Row 1: dc in 2nd ch from the hook and across ch2 turn (sts)

Row 2-6: dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 7-12: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 13-18: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 19-24: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 25-30: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to blue

Row 31-36: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 37-42: ch2, dc in each st across (these six will be all black, after this we will only be changing colors about halfway down the row)

Row 43: ch2, continuing with black dc in the next 69 sts, change to white and continue to end of row

Rows 44: ch2, still using white dc in the next 79 sts, pick up black where you left it and dc to the end of the row, ch 2

Row 45-48: repeat rows 43-44

Row 49-72: repeat rows 37 to 48

Row 73-78: repeat rows 37-42

DO NOT FASTEN OFF, you will now be working on the border, ch 1 and single crochet around the entire blanket, fasten off and weave in ends

Stars

You will be making 50!

Using a 3.25 mm or D hook

HDC 10 into a MR, sl st to first hdc

Ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next, hdc in 3rd ch, skip one st in beginning round 1, sl st to next (repeat for 5 points)

King

(starting with black)

CH150

Row 1: dc in 2nd ch from the hook and across ch2 turn (sts)

Row 2-7: dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 8-14: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 15-21: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to white

Row 22-28: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 29-35: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to blue

Row 36-42: ch2, dc in each st across

Change to black

Row 43-49: ch2, dc in each st across (these seven will be all black, after this we will only be changing colors about halfway down the row)

Row 50: ch2, continuing with black dc in the next 69 sts, change to white and continue to end of row

Rows 51: ch2, still using white dc in the next 79 sts, pick up black where you left it and dc to the end of the row, ch 2

Row 52-56: repeat rows 50-51

Row 57-84: repeat rows 43 to 56

Row 85-91: repeat rows 43-49

DO NOT FASTEN OFF, you will now be working on the border, ch 1 and single crochet around the entire blanket, fasten off and weave in ends

Stars

You will be making 50!

Using a 3.25 mm or D hook

HDC 10 into a MR, sl st to first hdc

Ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next, hdc in 3rd ch, skip one st in beginning round 1, sl st to next (repeat for 5 points)
